

Skate Park Rule Considerations

BEFORE YOU CAN SKATE

1. The skate park is for the use of [organization name] members and guests; check-in is required. Complete your registration and provide emergency contact information.
2. Sign the "Release from Liability" form. This must be done once each year. If a release is not on file, you will not be allowed to skate.
3. Wear all of the following safety equipment: helmet, knee pads, elbow pads, wrist guards. Anyone without proper equipment will be asked to leave.

PARTICIPATION RULES

1. Skate only when the park is open
2. Participants are to provide their own skateboard or roller blades
3. Only one person on the ramp at a time
4. Smoking and the use of tobacco products are not allowed in the skate park facility, which includes all the property inside the park fence
5. Alcoholic beverages and use of controlled substances, including unlawful use of prescription drugs, is not allowed on property
6. Chewing gum, food and beverages are not allowed on skate surfaces; glass bottles are not allowed anywhere inside the park
7. Obscene language, fighting, and unsportsmanlike conduct are not allowed
8. Fireworks, firearms, and weapons of any kind (concealed or not) are not allowed
9. All injuries must be reported immediately to the supervising attendant
10. Extreme recklessness will not be tolerated
11. No destroying or defacing the property
12. Clean up after yourself - No littering
13. Anyone who violates these rules will be asked to leave; repeated violations may result in revocation of skating privileges
14. The skate park attendant has the right to enforce these rules. Any questions or complaints should be referred to the [organization name]
