



Risk Management Program and Assessment Process

Risk management is the process of planning, organizing, leading, and controlling the activities of an organization in order to minimize the effects of risk on an organization's mission. Safe-Wise Consulting expands the process to include not just risks associated with accidental losses, but also financial, strategic, operational, and other risks. We work with organizations to provide a framework for risk management, which typically involves identifying particular events or circumstances relevant to the organization's objectives (risks and opportunities), assessing them in terms of likelihood and magnitude of impact, determining a response strategy, and monitoring progress.

Risk Assessment:

The first step for managing the risks of your organization is the assessment process. Organizations can develop an effective program for managing risk only after properly assessing and analyzing their operations and risks. By identifying and proactively addressing risks and opportunities, Organizations can protect their assets and create greater safety for their members, employees, volunteers and communities. Through our comprehensive assessment process Safe-Wise Consulting will integrate concepts of strategic planning, operational management, and internal control to create your organization's risk management plan.

Assessment Process:

Our assessment process offers both electronic and on-site components. The risk assessment process incorporates the following key elements for addressing risk for your organization:

Aquatic Safety – Our [Ready Guard program](#) is based on aquatic industry guidelines and core safety philosophies. It builds a system for maintaining the highest level of aquatic safety in all aquatic venues. Our assessment process will analyze and evaluate current practices and Lifeguard performance before setting a course for organizational improvement. Aquatic safety practices will be implemented to encourage organizational commitment and awareness along with monitoring strategies to ensure heightened vigilance.

Child Abuse Prevention – Our [comprehensive child abuse prevention program](#) builds strategies that protect children, staff and the organization. Child Abuse Prevention has no single prevention technique. Our assessment process emphasizes the strategies that must be embraced throughout the organization in order to reduce the opportunities for abuse. These strategies are based on nationally recognized guidelines, principles and values. Our work will help empower staff, children, families, the community and the organization to work together in protecting one of our most valuable assets.

Emergency Preparedness – Action during times of crisis can often affect the final outcome of critical situations. Being prepared for possible emergencies and crisis takes planning and practice. Facilities - Facility issues can often lead to accidents and losses. Key areas such as life-safety, maintenance, prevention and inspection practices are reviewed and strengthened in current facilities. Design considerations for accident/incident prevention, loss control and security are reviewed and strengthened for facilities in the design phase. This process is particularly effective because of our knowledge of common experiences and safety concerns at youth serving facilities.

Financial Control - Nonprofit organizations must be good stewards of the monies they receive. This includes incorporating sound financial controls into their daily activities as well as implementing policies that help the organization manage its finances. Safe-Wise works with your organization to ensure that proper checks and balances as well as overview practices are in place to protect your organization from financial harm.

Governance – The Board of Directors is the authority when it comes to overseeing a nonprofit organization. Their responsibility for implementing proper policies for staff to implement is important. Safe-Wise works with your organization to ensure proper governance practices and policies are in place. We also assist you with your training of volunteer leadership.
